GROUND RULES FOR J. B. WELLS ARENA - GONZALES, TX

- 1. Covered arena will NOT be open for practice at any time; however, the practice arena will be open for riding day and night.
- 2. For the safety of your horses, we ask that you NOT clip or tie horses to chain link fences anywhere on the grounds at any time. Also, NO horses are allowed on grass area around the cemetery.
- 3. RV PARKING SPOTS ONCE YOU ARE PARKED YOU MAY NOT MOVE they will be marking your RV and keeping the number you are in on file at the office IF YOU MOVE YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE GROUNDS AND WILL HAVE TO GO FIND SOMEWHERE ELSE FOR YOUR RV FOR THE WEEK you will be able to come on grounds to make a run but will have to leave after your run THIS WILL BE ENFORCED TO THE FULLEST
- 4. If you park in a RV spot and plan to run your generator you still have to pay for the spot. No generators are allowed to be ran overnight.
- 5. NO horses are allowed to be washed inside the horse stall barn. Horses can only be washed in the wash racks, located at the end of the Show Barn and the North corner of the big horse stall barn.
- 6. There will not be a honey wagon. Every RV spot has water, sewer, and electric hook-ups. Majority each spot has a 20, 30, and 50 amp service. There are some on the lower side that only have 50 amp service, so adapters may be needed.
- 7. For the safety and because the practice arena is available at all times, NO horses are allowed to be left in the practice arena over night. If a horse is on the premises over night they must be in a stall.
- 8. Bicycles, scooters, and roller blades are not allowed to be ridden in the bleacher area at any time.
- 9. Please don't stand at the rail around the arena. Be considerate of the spectators in the bleachers and handicap areas that came to support you.
- 10.NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE PARK.
- 11. All dogs on park grounds must be on a leash. NO DOGS IN THE ARENA AT ANY TIME
- 12. No horses are allowed on sidewalk area or tied close by. These areas are for spectators.

- All contestants must bring either their final report card for the 2024-2025 school year, or the <u>last</u>
 <u>previous six weeks report card</u>, or a letter from the school (on school stationary with school seal)
 stating that they are passing 70% of their subjects. The letter must be signed by school counselor,
 <u>principal or superintendent.</u>
- 2. Any contestant having a problem making the check in time on Sunday, May 25th, 2025 needs to call Anne Dollery (State Secretary) at 979-412-2551. ANY LATE ARRIVAL MUST BE **PREAPPROVED. If you show up without** talking to Anne Dollery (state secretary) YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE FINALS!
- 3. Check in will be Sunday, May 25th from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Expo. You must be checked in by 12 p.m. Campers and/or horses cannot be brought in and left on grounds or in stalls before Friday morning, May 23, 2025, starting at 8:00 AM This is open to anyone who wants to come on Friday but please note that the entrance gate will close at 7:00 PM on Friday and will not open back up until 7:00 AM Saturday morning. The City of Gonzales will have staff available 24 hours to help you with RV and stall assignment. When they take you to your assigned stall they will then take you to your region's RV area, anyone refusing to park in that area or move after they are parked they will be asked to leave the grounds and will not be allowed to park their trailer on the grounds.
 - a. There will no refunds after May 1st (entry fee, stall or rv reservation) without a medical release, and there will be no moving up after May 15th if a contestant drops out for any reason.
 - b. Each contestant will have a morning and afternoon run. The order will be reversed for the second go. The second go will not start until the first go is complete.
 - c. The first performance will be on Sunday, May 25 at 5pm, then we will go to 2 performances a day. The morning perfs will start at 8:30 a.m. and the afternoon perfs will start at 2:30p.m. The Short Go will start at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 31st and will be the only performance that day.

Proof of negative coggins test, taken within the 12 months prior to the State Finals, must be furnished along with a proper and current Health Certificate issued if you are crossing state lines by a licensed veterinarian within 45 days of the opening of the State Finals. Only one (1) horse will be allowed in each stall. A copy of these must be turned in when you get your stall assignment. PLEASE BRING A COPY!
- 5. The price of admission will be \$8.00 for adults and \$5.00 for a child for a performance. Season passes are \$60 for adults and \$40 for child and may be purchased from your region secretary when you turn in your entry form. Passes can be picked up when you check in. They will also be available for purchase at the finals.
- 6. The Dress Code will be as follows:
 - a. Full Dress code inside the fenced arena (hats, boots, long sleeves, and back numbers) while competing or sitting in the stands.
 - b. Back Number only in the stalling area and jack pot arena.





If a golf cart engine must be replaced, a New Engine Fee of \$2500 plus loss of revenue of \$1500 while the golf cart is out of service will be charged. If your golf cart is returned tampered with you will be charged as well. (NO Warning for this offense – this will result in loss of rental, fine and NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

 - c. If a golf cart engine has to be replaced, a New Engine Fee of \$2500 plus loss of revenue of \$1500 while the golf cart is out of service will be charged. If your golf cart is returned tampered with you will be charged as well. (NO Warning for this offense this will result in loss of rental, fine and NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN and will be reported to Texas Junior High School Rules Committee)
- 33. Do not exceed passenger or weight capacity allowed on the golf cart. Each occupant must be seated on the bench seat:
 - d. 2-passenger golf cart 2 people only
 - e. 4-passenger golf cart 4 people only
 - f. 6-passenger golf cart 6 people only
 - g. utility truck golf cart 2 people only; none shall occupy the utility bed as it is not designed nor rated for passengers
- 34. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted on the event grounds. Texting, alcohol and/or drug use while driving is strictly prohibited.
- 35. Reckless driving, abuse of the rules, and irresponsible driving will result in confiscation of your golf cart.

- 36. Absolutely no water balloon fights on golf carts. (NO Tolerance Policy 1st offense: golf cart can/will be confiscated for remainder of event with no refund).
- 37. Golf cart must be driven in a safe manner and all rules must be followed to maintain your golf cart privilege.
- 38. Operating a golf cart as well as being a passenger in a golf cart can pose a risk of injury or death; the operator must adhere to all safety rules to ensure the safety of everyone attending the event.
- 39. Metro Golf Cars, Inc. Operation Hours: Daily 8am-6pm.
- 40. Security will be onsite and arranged by Metro Golf Cars, Inc. and JHSRA these entities have full authority to confiscate golf carts, write tickets and/or warnings, and stop any golf cart on the event grounds for rules infractions and/or unsafe driving. Periodic governor checks will be performed throughout the day on any/all golf carts.

It is expressly understood and agreed that Metro Golf Cars, JB Wells Park, the Texas JHSRA, their staff, owners or operators and agents shall not be held liable for damages or injuries of any kind, whether to persons and/or property, and/or loss of time, and any other loss arising from the use, operation of, or in any way connected with the golf cart rental. I have read and understand that this is a legally binding agreement and accept all the terms of this agreement. Failure to comply with these terms may result in the termination of my event credentials, the golf cart being impounded and forfeiture of golf cart privileges for the remainder of the event WITH NO REFUNDS GIVEN.

Tug-Of-War Competition Rules

Participation Warning: There are inherent risks of mental and physical injury in Tug-of-war. Our goal is to reduce or eliminate as many risks as reasonably possible to provide a safe program. This does not mean that injuries will not happen. We ask for your full cooperation in following instructions regarding proper conduct, proper use of equipment and facilities, and adherence to the rules of Tug-of war as established.

General Information:

- 1. Region Participation: Each region will send one Adult person per region to assist with the
 - 2 people (Region 6 & 7) (Strong men) holding the flag in middle of rope before they start game
 - 1 person Reworking the flour after each game
 - 4 people Managing each region as they play
 - 1 person- Managing tournament board
 - 1 person Keeping score best 2 out of 3 games
 - 1 person Checking in each team
- 2. Teams: A team consists of six (7) participants, 1 coach, 3 males and 3 females. All players must be from the same region and be a contestant in the TJHFR.
- 3. Contestant Numbers: All team members must wear their contestant numbers on their back.
- 4. Bleeding: During any Tug-of-war match, if a referee or director detects a participant who is bleeding, has an open wound, or has an excessive amount of blood on their clothing, the game will be stopped. In order for the participant to continue to play, they must have the bleeding stopped, the wound covered, and clothing changed. This is the only time a substitute is allowed.
- 5. Jewelry: No jewelry may be worn while participating in games. Only exception is for a medical condition.
- **6. Sportsmanship:** Unsportsmanlike conduct will NOT be tolerated. Any person may be ejected from a game and playing area at any time without warning for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 7. Protest: There will be NO protests.
- 8. Gloves: Are strongly recommended for all participants.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Each team is allowed to start and /or finish the match with a minimum of 4 participants. Teams must still be at least 2 females or more.


